Police Advice

The police have advised the Parish Council to alert residents to a residential burglary that took place on 3rd June just before 3pm on Harewood Road. Whilst the occupant was gardening at the front of the house the suspect entered the property at the rear through insecure patio doors and stole property before being disturbed by the occupant and making off over the fields.

Residents are urged to lock all doors front and back even whilst in the garden.

HGV Petition

The Parish Council have been campaigning for several years to restrict the number of HGV vehicles passing through Collingham, particularly on Harewood Road. The issue was raised by residents at a public meeting held recently by the Parish Council to discuss Leeds City Council's 20mph speed limit programme for the city. Ward Councillor Matthew Robinson's petition to restrict the HGV access through Collingham is now up to 650 signatures and is still open. A deputation to a full Council meeting will be now be made.
